## Water for developers, contradicts region's message

*Region's water wise message for Halton Hills Councillors*

**Halton Hills:** Despite the Region's water concerns for not only our municipal supply, but also a sustainable ecosystem, The Tanner reports that town council "will approve plans" for a 23-unit condominium development complex in Acton.

According to the report, a company 'formerly known' as 1001 Developments and West Meadows Phase 3 is undertaking a plan to develop a two acre site on the southeast corner of Wallace Street and Doctor Moore Court, under the name of The Charleston Group.

The Halton Herald has not had any responses to date, from any Acton council members, including the Mayor who lives in Acton, for their water wise plan that will sustain the growth of 23 more families in Acton.

Council's message has been of late, a growing message to conserve. Expect soon the water-wise council of Halton Hills to further expect their constituents to cut back even further on their current consumption, to sustain what appears to be, more mismanaged growth.
